

Three features together make the book more unique than many advanced texts on the market: word frequency rankings for the HSK (the PRC's standardized test of Chinese proficiency), vocabulary building skills and reading skills.

### **NEW FEATURES:**

- 9 new main readings include those on contemporary social issues such as Internet culture, the health effects of environmental pollution, and divorce in China. The book also includes 11 revised and updated versions of the essays from *A New Text for a Modern China*.
- A new design makes it easier for users to pick out the wealth of relevant usage notes, important idioms, and clearly presented grammar examples.
- The exercise section has been greatly expanded by focusing on strategies for effective reading and writing, as well as strategies for speaking in class discussions or presentations. A new Vocabulary Building Skills exercise also helps students acquire vocabulary more efficiently. Each vocabulary list includes HSK rankings for words covered on the HSK exam. With the exercises integrated into the textbook, a separate workbook is no longer necessary.
- New audio CDs will also be available.

The book encourages students to comprehend written texts as organized, coherent works, and reinforces crucial skills for effective communication in written Chinese. *Reading into a New China* is the perfect tool for building reading comprehension and stylistic skills along with relevant, timely cultural knowledge.
